Public Works received bids on April 2, 2015 at 10:00 A.M. for the purchase of the above listed equipment to be used by the Public Works Street Division. It will be installed on two new truck chassis that are being purchased. The trucks will be used for normal operations and to maintain streets. Funds have been appropriated in the FY 14/15 Road-Use-Tax Capital Equipment budget for the purchase of this equipment.

Analysis of Issue
