**Subject:** Open Burning of yard waste resolution



Brief History

ACTION:

For Discussion and possible vote Monday April 13, 2015

The City Council passed Ordinance 2122 on May 10, 2010. This ordinance essentially banned open burning of most yard waste. Since its passage, the Council has allowed temporary and brief suspension of the ban on burning yard waste in the fall and the spring. At the request of a member of the public several council members directed me to draft the resolution allowing burning of yard waste this spring.

## **Analysis of Issue**

The attached resolution allows the burning of yard waste starting Saturday April 18 through Sunday, April 26. The time period includes two weekends and the week days in between.

The manner in which the resolution is constructed includes yard waste, (leaves, brush, twigs, clippings, etc.) as an exception to the open burn prohibition. This essentially keeps the remaining requirements of the new ordinance in place for safety (e.g. height, size and location of fire). As in the past when open burning of yard waste was allowed, during these two time periods, the fire department will order a yard waste fire extinguished if there is a complaint, or prohibit any and all fires based on weather conditions.

## **BUDGET IMPACT**

## **Staff Conclusions**

It is the Council's discretion to put the moratorium in place. Staff recommends that it be limited to short periods and the remainder of the existing rule are maintained and that the fire department has the discretion to extinguish open burning.
