Brief History

The City of Fort Dodge requires that any water service leak be repaired in a timely manner to limit water loss and continue water conservation practices. When it is determined a property has a water service leak, the owner is immediately notified of the water leak and the necessity of having it repaired. This notification states that failure to have the proper repairs made by a licensed plumber will result in the City having the repairs made and billing the owner accordingly. It also states that failure to pay for these costs can result in these costs being assessed against the property. If the property owner has not paid the outstanding invoice, a public hearing is set to consider assessment for collection with property taxes.

Analysis of Issue

The Property owner has been notified of the public hearing by mail.
