Subject: Municipal Building – Priority 2 Renovations

Form of Contract & Opinion of Probable Cost

Brief History

In 2007 and 2008 the Building Evaluation and Recommendation Team (BERT) made recommendations to the City Council regarding the Municipal Building. That team recommended that the City stay in the current Municipal Building. They also recommended that the front stairs to the building be repaired, an elevator be installed, additional HVAC improvements, water damaged areas be repaired, and additional waterproofing and tuck-pointing work be completed.

A new roof was installed and minor tuck-pointing was completed in 2008/2009. New boilers were installed and a new fresh air system was completed in 2012.

On April 14, 2014 Council approved a contract with Allers Associates Architects for the 2014 Renovations. The contracts provides for architectural/engineering design services for the following renovations to the existing Municipal Building: a new three stop elevator, renovation of the east end of the building to new council chambers, creating restrooms near the new council chambers, renovations of Clerk's office, and renovate area near elevator on second floor. The cost of these services, which include schematic, design development, construction documents, bidding phase and construction phase, is \$60,500 plus reimbursable expenses.

A bid letting date was set for January 29, 2015 at 10:00 a.m.

Analysis of Issue

The Council needs to hold a public hearing and then approve the plans, specifications, form of contract, and opinion of probably costs. An agenda item will be presented to Council on February 9, 2015 regarding the award of contract.

Budget Impact

This project will be funded by General Obligation Bonds. Bonds in the amount of \$700,000 were issued with the Series 2014 bond sale. The Architects Opinion of Probable Cost is \$586,600.

Strategic Plan Impact

Policy D.4.2: Advanced planning for all infrastructure facilities shall be supported and routinely updated. Facilities benefited by advanced planning shall include, at minimum, schools, health care, residential areas, roads, water, sewer, storm water management, parks, recreation, and greenways.
