#### **Brief History**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. N. Reconstruction Project (N. 15<sup>th</sup> St. to N. 22<sup>nd</sup> St.) is programmed in the approved Capital Improvements Plan for reconstruction in 2018. Due to the harshness of this past winter, 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. N. between N. 20<sup>th</sup> St. and N. 22<sup>nd</sup> St. has fallen into a state of disrepair. It is Staff's opinion that the City would only wasting money if we tried to complete a repair project on this section of street. Staff does not believe that a repair will hold up to the traffic on this street for 4 years. In 2011, the traffic count on 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. N. was 6,600. Now the Fort Dodge Middle School has opened out on 32<sup>nd</sup> St., Staff believes the traffic count could be much higher.

On April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014 City Council agreed to enter into an agreement with Bolton & Menk do design a two phased approach to repairing 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave N from N 15<sup>th</sup> Street to N 22<sup>nd</sup> Street. The first phase to be completed during the 2015 construction season is from N 18<sup>th</sup> Street to N 22<sup>nd</sup> Street.

# **Analysis of Issue**

A public hearing and bid date is required to be set to approve the plans and specifications, form of contract and estimate of costs for Phase 1 of this project. A bid date of February 10<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm and a public hearing date of February 23<sup>rd</sup> at 6:00 is proposed.

# **Budget Impact**

Construction of this project could be paid from Local Option Sales Tax, Water Utility, Sanitary Sewer Utility, and Storm Sewer Utility funds. The Engineer's estimate of probable construction costs are \$1,135,000.

## Strategic Plan Impact

Policy D.4.2: Advanced planning for all infrastructure facilities shall be supported and routinely updated. Facilities benefited by advanced planning shall include, at minimum, schools, health care, residential areas, roads, water, sewer, storm water management, parks, recreation, and greenways.

Policy D.4.1: Recognizing that infrastructure has a powerful influence on growth and development, the availability of infrastructure (along with other factors) should determine where development will occur in the city, rather than the other way around.

## **Impact on Existing Plans**

This project was included in the 2013-2018 Capital Improvement Plan adopted by the Council.
