
- 1) Sidewalks will follow the lay of the land, unless otherwise noted.
- 2) Walk thickness will be according to labels.
- 3) All sidewalks to meet SUDAS/ADA/PROWAG requirements
- 4) All excavation to establish sidewalk grades shall be considered incidental to the sidewalk.
- 5) Fill and seeding will be conducted by the city, following completion of the project.
- 6) The expansion material around buildings if noted shall be incidental to the project.
- 7) Saw cuts shall be incidental to the project.
- 8) Please protect any conduit as noted.
- 9) Disposal of removed material, including sod/turf shall be the responsibility of the contractor.
- 10) All coordination of the project will be with the representative from the Parks Department with the City of Fort Dodge.




