Park Hours: Open everyday, sunrise to sunset

Park Rules

- ATVs and motorcycles must have and display a valid DNR registration (321I). Riders must carry registration papers.
- 2. Helmets are required for all operators.
- 3. No person under the age of 12 may operate an ATV in the park (3211.21).
- 4. ATV riders under 18 years of age must have a valid safety certificate (3211.26).
- 5. Riding double is prohibited on all ATVs and motorcycles (3211.14).
- 6. Riding off trail or in prohibited areas is illegal (3211.14(f.)).
- Careless, reckless, or negligent operation is prohibited (3211.14(b.)).
- Speed greater than reasonable or proper under all existing circumstances is prohibited (3211.14(a.)).
- Riding while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or narcotics is prohibited (3211.14(c.)).
- ATVs and motorcycles may not exceed an engine noise limit above 86 decibles measured at a distance of 50 feet (3211.12).
- 11. Riders must stay on trail and follow all posted signs.
- 12. ATVs and motorcycles need to be trailered to the park.
- 13. Youth Riding Area is limited to machines of 119 cc or less and is intended for beginning or novice riders only.
