Mayor Bemrich called meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Present: Council Members: David Flattery, Jeffrey Halter, Don Wilson, Kim Alstott, Terry Moehnke and Dean Hill. Absent: Andy Fritz.

Moved by Alstott to approve the agenda for this meeting. Motion seconded by Moehnke. Aye: 6. Nay: 0. Motion carried.

Mayor Bemrich announced that this is the time and place for a public hearing to consider vacating the following public right-of-way located in Webster County, Iowa, described as follows: that portion of alley which extends from North 10th Street easterly and includes all of said alley which abuts Lots Five (5), Four (4), Ten (10) and Nine (9) in said Block 25, East Fort Dodge Addition to Fort Dodge, Webster County, Iowa. Mayor Bemrich asked for comments, written or oral. There being none, he declared the hearing closed.

City Clerk Nemmers introduced first consideration of Ordinance No. 2214, an Ordinance Providing for the Vacation of Public Right-of-Way in the City of Fort Dodge, Webster County, Iowa. Council Member Wilson moved to pass on first consideration Ordinance No. 2214 as introduced. Motion seconded by Hill. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: Flattery, Halter, Wilson, Alstott, Moehnke and Hill. Nay: 0. Absent: Fritz. Motion carried. Council Member Wilson moved to waive the second and third reading of Ordinance No. 2214 and adopt same. Motion seconded by Hill. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: 6. Nay: 0. Absent: Fritz. Ordinance No. 2214 was adopted.

City Clerk Nemmers introduced Resolution No. 14-06-164 Directing the Disposal of an Interest in Real Property Following Public Hearing. Council Member Wilson moved to adopt Resolution No. 14-06-164 as introduced and dispose of property in the amount of \$50.00 to Holy Trinity. Motion seconded by Moehnke. On roll call, the vote was: Aye: 6. Nay: 0. Absent: Fritz. Resolution was adopted.

Mayor Bemrich announced that this is the time and place for a public hearing to consider a Development Agreement between the City and Gale W. McKinney in connection with the construction of an addition to the Iowa Outdoors Store retail facility situated at 1597 3rd Avenue NW in the Center City and Industrial Park Urban Renewal Areas, which Agreement provides for certain financial incentives in the form of incremental property tax payments to the Developer in a total amount not exceeding \$40,000 as authorized by Section 403.9 of the Code of Iowa. Mayor Bemrich asked for comments, written or oral. There being none, he declared the hearing closed.
