Brief History

In September of 2013 the City sold the property at 532 South 16th Street to Brian E. Bockoven and Debra K. Bockoven, and Trent Bockoven & Jessica M. Bockoven through re-developmental proposal. Terms of the special warranty deed required that the house be re-developed and brought into conformance with all currently adopted City Codes within one year of transfer. To date, the redevelopment of this property has not vet been completed.

Analysis of Issue

The Special Warranty Deed states the property can revert back to the City if the terms are not met within the required timeframe. Mr. Trent Bockoven has requested an extension to the term until February 15, 2015 to allow them to complete the work.

Budget Impact

There is no budget impact.
