Subject: 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. N. Infrastructure Improvement Project Approve Pay Estimate #8 Final & Final Acceptance

ACTION: For vote Monday, July 28, 2014

## **Brief History**

In 2008, Kuehl & Payer Ltd. was retained by the City to design and develop assessment plats for the 2008 Street Improvements Project Phase I. Only Area I was constructed. This project is Area 3 from that original contract including 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue North from 7<sup>th</sup> street to 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Dewitt Street from 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue North to 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue North. In order to move forward, the plans need to be updated to include elements required by our Street Policy, updated specifications, utilities, and some geometry modifications. The agreement included only services up to the bid letting. Council approved a contract on May 9, 2011 with Kuehl and Payer. On March 26, 2012, Council approved setting a bid letting date on April 12, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. to receive bids for this project. A public hearing was set for April 23, 2012 at 6:00 p.m. to approve plans and specifications, form of contract, estimate of costs and to award a contract. A bid letting was held on April 12, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. Council awarded the contract to Hovey Construction in the amount of \$819,290.42 on April 23, 2012. Change Order #1 was necessary to delete some items from the contract and add some items as described in the attached change order. The additions amount to \$59,208.90, the deletions equal \$20,416.00, the difference of \$38,792.90 will be deducted from the contingency allowance. There is \$36,207.10 remaining in the contingency allowance. The Change Order also adds 32 calendar days to the contract. The original completion date was August 6, 2012. With the 32 days added, the new completion date is September 7, 2012. Delays were encountered due to unforeseen conditions with MidAmerican facilities and several other unforeseen issues. Change Order #1 was approved on July 9, 2012. Change Order #2 was approved on February 11, 2013 and rectified quantities for the project and resulted in a reduction of the contract by \$33,185.51. Change Order #3 was approved on September 9, 2013 and was necessary to delete the seeding line items and add sodding to the project. The change increases the contract by \$13,449.10 to \$799,554.10. The original contract amount was \$819,290.42. On February 24, 2014, Council approved Pay Estimate #7 Sub-Final in the amount of \$38,377.70.

## Analysis of Issue

I & S Group submitted a Notice of Acceptability, showing that the project has been completed in substantial compliance with the plans and specification. Pay Estimate #8 Final is now due to Hovey Construction in the amount of \$1,600.00.

## Budget Impact

The CIP plan approved by Council on April 25, 2011 budgeted \$536,000 for this project. Funds for the project were allocated from the following sources: Storm Water Utility - \$350,000, Local Option Sales Tax - \$90,000, Water Utility - \$51,000, and Sanitary Sewer Utility - \$45,000. The bid amount and the engineering fees (\$30,145) associated with the project are above the budget. All costs above the budget will be paid for from Local Option Sales Tax revenue. This is made possible due to the lower project costs associated with the Feelhaver Area street project.

### Strategic Plan Impact

Policy D.4.2: Advanced planning for all infrastructure facilities shall be supported and routinely updated. Facilities benefited by advanced planning shall include, at minimum, schools, health care, residential areas, roads, water, sewer, storm water management, parks, recreation, and greenways.

Policy D.4.1: Recognizing that infrastructure has a powerful influence on growth and development, the availability of infrastructure (along with other factors) should determine where development will occur in the city, rather than the other way around.

Policy D.4.7: Adequate utilities infrastructure (water supply, sewage collection and treatment capacity, storm water management, etc.) must be in place before the new development it serves may be occupied.

Strategy D.4.4: Prepare a Storm water Master Plan for the City of Fort Dodge.

### **Impact on Existing Plans**

This project was included in the 2011-2016 Capital Improvement Plan adopted by the Council.
