Brief History

Public Works Department has received quotes for the purchase of CRS2 (liquid emulsified asphalt) for the summer and fall season of 2015. Our anticipated needs are 35,000 gallons of CRS2.

Analysis of Issue

CRS2 is used for the repair of potholes on the city streets. Bids have been received from two companies for the purchase of 35,000 gallons of CRS-2 for the summer and fall seasons. Either of these companies would be able to supply the full requirement of CRS2 for the season.

Jebro, Inc. Sioux City, Iowa	\$1.8290 / gallon
Bituminous Materials and Supply Des Moines, IA	\$1.90 / gallon

This is an approved expenditure through the Central Garage Revolving Account funds as set aside by the City Council in the FY 2014/15 and 2015/16 budgets.
