*According to COBRA rules, City of Fort Dodge employees are eligible to continue medical coverage through the City's plan for an additional 18 months at their own expense or until they reach retirement age as defined in Iowa Code §509A.13. Employees who retire at the age of 55 may choose to use HSA monies to pay their premium for coverage through the City until they reach age 65.

**At age 65, HSA monies can be used to pay for Medicare parts A, B & D and Medicare HMO premiums tax free and penalty free. Once a person enrolls in Medicare (any part), they can no longer contribute to an HSA.
