**Re: Lane Closures UPDATE – 5<sup>th</sup> Ave S from S 12<sup>th</sup> St to S 15<sup>th</sup> St**

Beginning Monday, September 17<sup>th</sup> at approximately 4am, weather permitting, traffic on 5<sup>th</sup> Ave S from S 12<sup>th</sup> St to S 15<sup>th</sup> St will be shifted to the opposite side of the road as two-way traffic. Traffic will be reduced to 1 lane in both directions with all traffic shifted to the south portion of the road. The side streets of S 13<sup>th</sup> St and S 14<sup>th</sup> St will remain blocked, therefore traffic will not be allowed on or off of 5<sup>th</sup> Ave S at the intersections of S 13<sup>th</sup> St and S 14<sup>th</sup> St.

There may be periodic and alternating lane closures throughout the summer without notice. Speed limits may be reduced and enforced. Motorists are urged to use an alternate route and caution in the area. Stay alert to traffic control, signage, and emergency vehicles.

This closure is part of the 2018 PCC Patch Project. Additional closures may be issued or occur throughout the summer as the project progresses.
