**NOTICE TO UTILITY CUSTOMERS:**

Beginning this month, you may notice a change to your water bill. The State of Iowa is requiring cities to separate the taxes charged on utility bills.

Residential customers will now see “Water Excise Tax” instead of “Sales Tax.”

Commercial customers will see a “Water Excise Tax” and “Sales Tax” (this is for sanitary sewer). These are not increases, just a change in wording.
