Board of Adjustment 5 members	5-year	1 st Tuesday of month @ 5:30 PM in Council Chamber	Oversees compliance with zoning ordinances,
Board of Animal Appeals 3 members	3-year	When there's an appeal in Council Chamber	Has jurisdiction to hear and decide appeals to decisions made by Animal Warden
Board of Appeals 5 members	5-year	When there's an appeal in Council Chamber	Hears and decides appeals with regard to suitability of alternate materials and methods of construction and reasonable interpretation of FD Plumbing, Electrical, Mechanical ordinances to provide for adoption of rules/regulations and repeal ordinances in conflict therewith
Cable TV Commission 5 members	3-year	As often as necessary	Provides harmonious resolution of complaints between citizen subscribers and promoted compliance with the City's cable TV Franchise and regulated ordinances
Charter Review Commission Variable	1-year	Decennially	Shall review existing Charter and within twelve months recommend any Charter amendments that it deems necessary
Civil Service Commission 3 members	4-year	Annually in April; or when necessary in connection with the test and certification of civil service	Insures fairness in hiring in police and fire departments
Council Salary Review Board 5 members	4-year	December of each even- numbered year	Recommends salaries for Council & Mayor
EEO Commission 3 employees	2-year	Every three months or when necessary in Council Chamber	Ensures that City is in compliance with equal employment opportunity through education
Electrical Examining Board 5 members	2-year	As often as necessary	Provide for exam and licensing of electrical contractor, journeymen electricians and registration of maintenance electricians in order to protect public safety, health and welfare
Historical Preservation Commission 7 members	5-year	1 st Monday of month @ 4 PM in Council Chamber	Safeguard City's historic sites & districts, promote uses of historic buildings, educate public re historic significance
Human Rights Commission 4 City/3 County members	2-year	1 st Wednesday of month @ 5:00 Pm in Council Chamber	Enforce policies of Iowa & Federal Civil Rights acts as well as ADA guidelines and provide active assistance to prevent and eliminate discriminatory practices

Library Board 5 members	5-year	4 th Monday of month @ 4:00 PM @ Library	Has control and supervision of library, its director & employees and their salaries, their personnel issues, to oversee budget and manage trust funds and gifts
Mechanical Board 7 members	2-year	Meet at such intervals as may be necessary but not less than twice a year	Provides for examination, licensing and registration of heating contractors, ventilating and cooling contractors, refrigeration contractors, appliance dealers/installers & maintenance mechanics, and provide for collection of fees therefore and penalties for violation of this chapter
Municipal Housing Agency 5 members	2-year	4 th Tuesday of month at 12:00 PM at Agency office	Oversees the Housing Agency operations including budget and expenses
Parks & Rec Commission 7 members 4 City/3 County members	5-year	3 rd Wednesday of Month at 4:00 PM in Council Chamber	Governs rules and regulations for use of parks, as well as recreational facilities, and rec programs
Planning & Zoning Commission 7 members	5-year	2 nd and 4 th Tuesday of month at 4:00 PM in Council Chamber	Reviews and makes recommendation on zoning questions or re-zoning issues, as well as development of subdivisions.
Plumbing Board 5 members	2-year	Meet at such intervals as may be necessary but not less than twice a year	Provide for examination and licensing of plumbers and water conditioning and treatment contractors, and registration of maintenance plumbers in order to protect public safety, health and welfare
S.S.M.I.D. 9 members	3-years	3 rd Tuesday of month at 4:00 PM in Council Chamber	To undertake actions and the design and construction of any and all improvements authorized by Chapter 386 of the Code of Iowa and the performance of administration redevelopment and revitalization of the District as authorized by Chapter 386 of the Code of Iowa, all of which actions and improvements are intended to benefit the property of the proposed District
Water Conditioning & Treatment Board 5 members	2-year	Meet at such intervals as may be necessary but not less than twice a year	Provides for examination, licensing and registration of water conditioning and treatment contractors in order to protect public safety, health and welfare
