Tree Purchase Offered for \$25.00

The City of Fort Dodge will be offering trees for \$25.00 for planting on city right-of-way. To qualify, residents must have had an Ash Tree removed because of the imminent progression of the Emerald Ash Borer. Residents must also meet the minimum criteria for tree planting on city right-of-ways. Minimum standards will be strictly enforced.

- Must have a minimum of 9' from curb to sidewalk.
- **Check underground utilities. One calls service # is 811 on your telephone or 1-800-292-8989.**
- For planting purposes, 50 feet spacing for shade trees. Spacing for low growing trees under power lines should be 30 feet.
- Minimum distance of 5 feet from water service stop boxes.
- Minimum distance of 10 feet from hydrants, poles, transformers, telephone junction boxes, manholes and driveway approaches.
- Minimum distance from street lights should be 25 feet.
- Must sign up and pay at the Parks & Recreation office, 819 1st Avenue South, prior to distribution. Tree supply will be limited.
- Trees will be ready for pick-up later this Fall 2019. Please call Kevin at 515-302-4994 to arrange a time to pick up the tree between 7am – 3pm Monday – Friday at the maintenance facility located at 1450 Oleson Park Avenue at the far south end of Oleson Park.
- If you do not meet these requirements you may purchase trees to be planted in your front yard on your private property.
